I refer to your email dated 3 December 2025, requesting the following under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

- 1) *“The amount spent on mobile services to each of Spark NZ, One NZ/Vodafone NZ, and 2 degrees,*
- 2) *The amount spent on other technology products/services to each of Spark NZ, One NZ/Vodafone NZ, 2 degrees, and Datacom*

*Both preferably on an annually basis for the last ten years (or however long you have the data for). If the split between mobile and other tech spend is not available, then an aggregate spend for each of the three telcos would work as well”*

Please find enclosed two tables outlining the amount spent on mobile services and other technology services to each of Spark NZ, One NZ/Vodafone NZ, and 2 degrees.
