





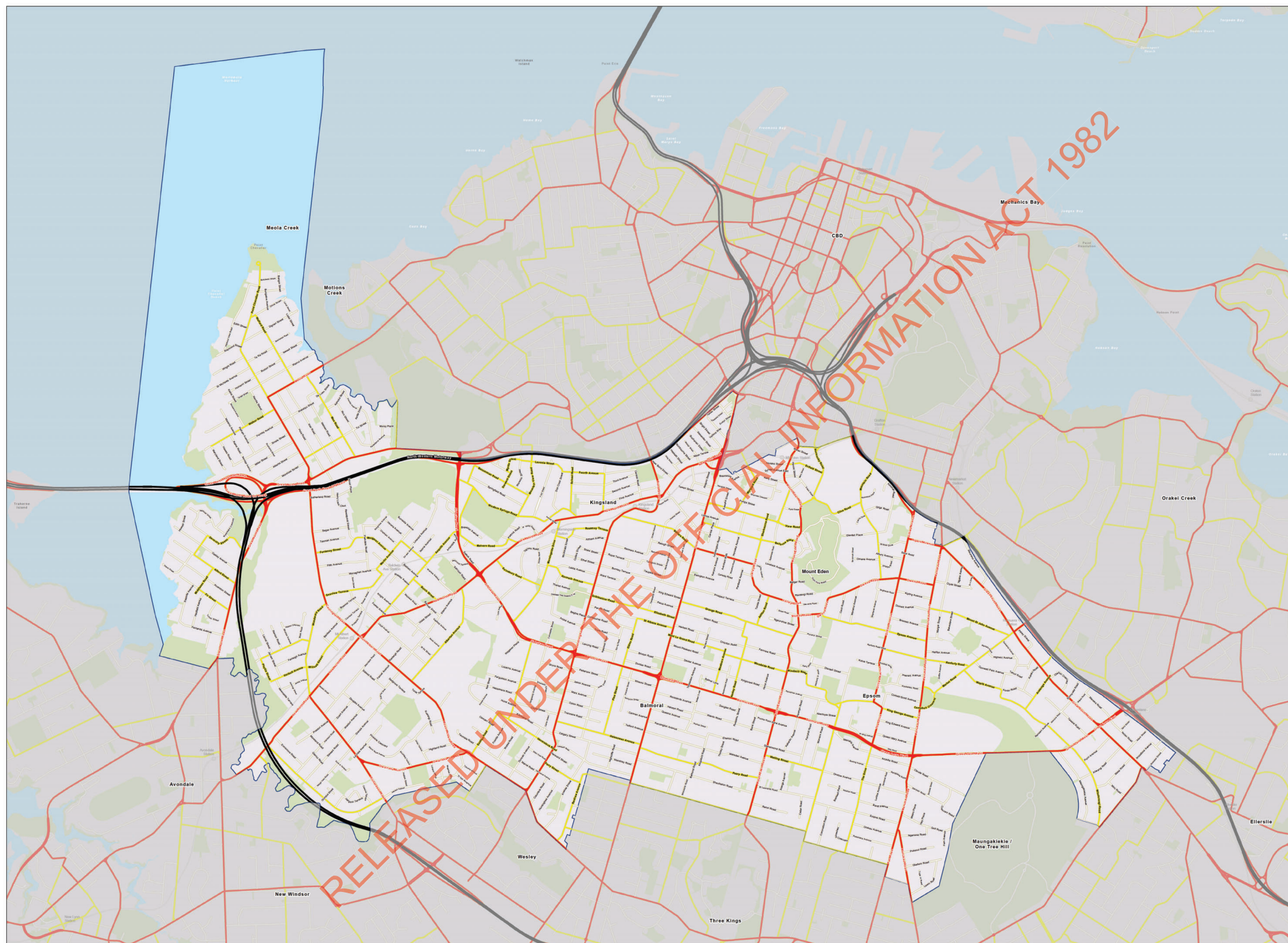

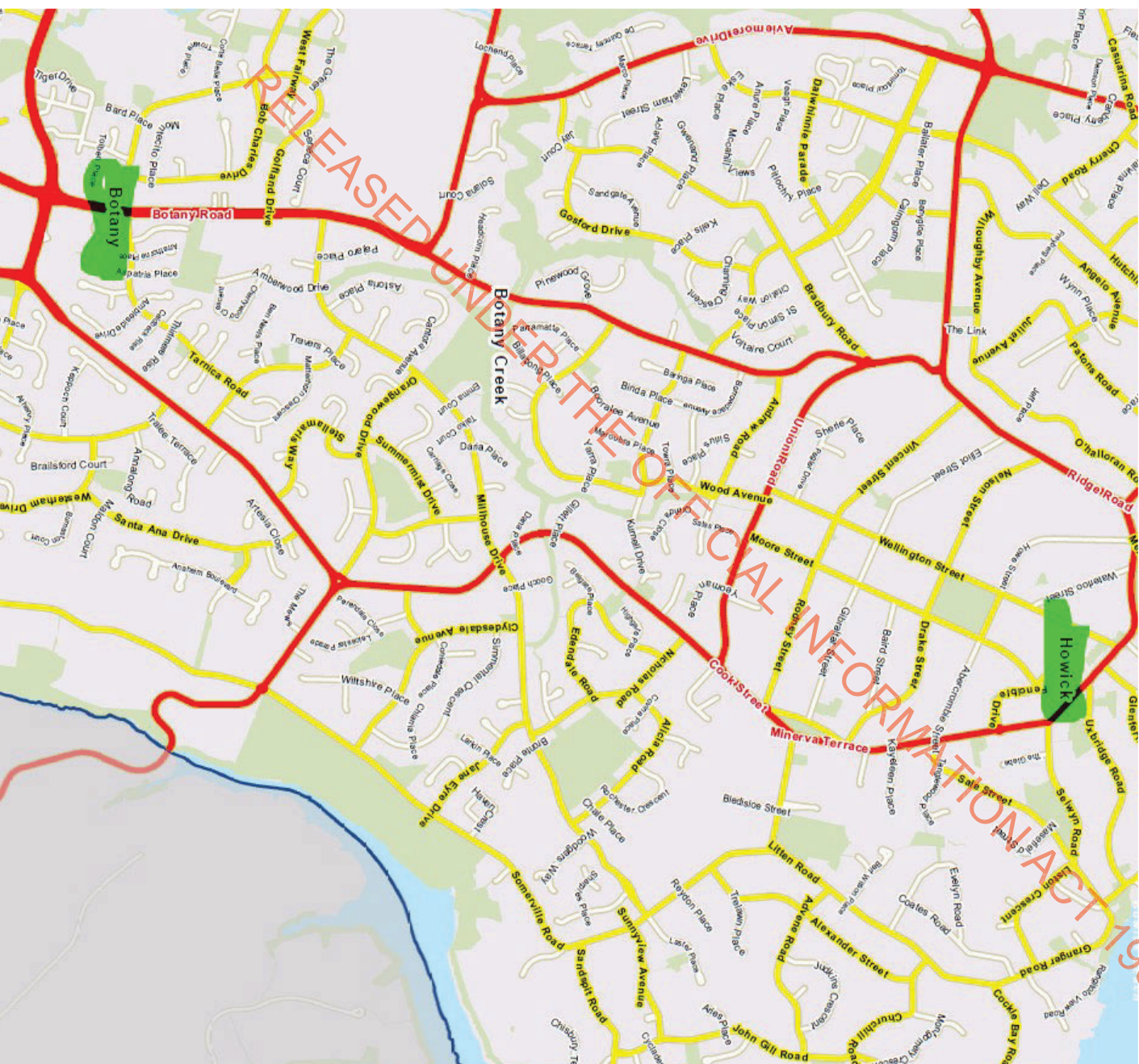

We are pressing on with drafting instructions for the transport governance work (while of course now having to factor in briefing the incoming Minister).

We are enabled to have some specific conversations with Council and AT staff to support the drafting instructions.

Megan - I wanted to get your comfort on some further conversations with people in your area and advice on who best to contact.

- We would like to test our latest thinking on **local board powers**. We will check with Hamish Bunn at AT and also thought another conversation with Adam Milina would be useful and anyone else, such as Claire, that you think should join that discussion
- **s 9(2)(f)(iv)**, it would also be useful to talk to your manager/team leader for bylaws as well as people at AT who manage the current transport bylaws. This is a general type of conversation to ensure whatever ends up in legislation is practical from an operational point of view.
If you could let me know some contacts in your policy area and AT and provide them with a bit of context that would be great.

Once we have had these conversations, we can share with you both where we are landing on local boards.
