On 17 September 2019, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- 1 **noted** that the Maritime Transport (Infringement Fees for Offences – Kai Iwi Lakes Navigation Safety Bylaw 2017) Regulations 2019 (the Regulations) will allow the Northland Regional Council to enforce the Kai Iwi Lakes Navigation Safety Bylaw 2017, which came into force on 1 July 2018;
- 2 **authorised** the submission of the Maritime Transport (Infringement Fees for Offences – Kai Iwi Lakes Navigation Safety Bylaw 2017) Regulations 2019 [PCO 21937/2.0] to the Executive Council;
- 3 **noted** that the Regulations will come into force on 24 October 2019.
