Transport System 2019/20 Rules Programme

Portfolio Transport

On 19 June 2019, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee:

- 1 **noted** that Transport Ministers are empowered by primary legislation to make transport rules on matters covering land (road and rail) transport, civil aviation, maritime safety and marine protection;
- 2 **authorised** Transport Ministers to progress the proposed Transport System 2019/20 Rules Programme, as set out in Appendix 1 of the paper under DEV-19-SUB-0165;
- 3 **noted** that the Transport System 2019/20 Rules Programme contributes to the government's priorities in the land, maritime and aviation domains;
- 4 **noted** that all transport rules are publicly consulted on prior to Ministerial approval being sought, and that Cabinet will be informed of any significant risks before any public consultation occurs;
- 5 **agreed** that Transport Ministers may make rules arising from the Transport System 2019/20 Rules Programme without further reference to Cabinet, unless indicated otherwise, or a significant policy issue or risk emerges during development;
- 6 **noted** that Transport Ministers may move policy investigations projects listed in the Transport System 2019/20 Rules Programme into the rule amendment stage, and will notify Cabinet of any significant policy issues associated with the proposals.
