Civil Aviation Authority Pricing Review 2020: Release of Discussion Document

Portfolio Transport

On 20 November 2019, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee:

- 1 **agreed** to the Civil Aviation Authority releasing the discussion document under DEV-19-SUB-0312 as part of its consultation with stakeholders about proposed increases to aviation levies, fees and charges for 2020/21 to 2022/23;
- 2 **agreed** that a Crown loan of \$12 million be the preferred option, in principle, to fund the capital investment required for the CAA's new regulatory technology platform;
- 3 **agreed** that the costs of the Regulatory Functions under the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996 (HSNO) be levy funded mainly from the Agricultural Operations Safety Levy;
- 4 **agreed** that the discussion document under DEV-19-SUB-0312 may be revised to reflect any government decisions about funding for the Civil Aviation Authority's Regulatory Technology Platform and/or HSNO costs, without being referred back to Cabinet.
