## Maritime Transport (Infringement Fees for Offences - Manawatū River) and Tributaries Navigation Safety Bylaw 2022) Regulations 2023

**Portfolio Transport** 

On 8 June 2023, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- **noted** that the Maritime Transport (Infringement Fees for Offences Manawatū River and 1 Tributaries Navigation Safety Bylaw 2022) Regulations 2023 (the Regulations) allow Horizons Regional Council to effectively enforce the Manawatū River and Tributaries Navigation Safety Bylaw 2022, which came into force in July 2022;
- authorised the submission to the Executive Council of the Maritime Transport 2 (Infringement Fees for Offences—Manawatū River and Tributaries Navigation Safety Bylaw 2022) Regulations 2023 [PCO 25393/10.0];
- 20ACTIVEOME 20ACTIVAÇÃO 3 **noted** that the Regulations will come into force on 13 July 2023.
