

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER VARYING A SCHEDULED INTERNATIONAL AIR SERVICE LICENCE

Pursuant to 184(4) of the Civil Aviation Act 2023, and further to an application received from British Airways Plc., the Secretary for Transport proposes to vary the airline's Scheduled International Air Service Licence to include the new provisions:

The licensee may carry on scheduled international air services and non-scheduled international flights without capacity constraints and in both directions over the routes listed below:

- (a) optionally from points behind the United Kingdom, via the United Kingdom, optionally via any intermediate points, to points in New Zealand, and optionally to points beyond; and
- (b) points in New Zealand to any points other than points in the United Kingdom.
