**Civil Aviation (Direction to Require Searching for Inorganic Powders, Liquids, Aerosols, and Gels)
Amendment Notice 2025**

This Notice is made under section 152 of the Civil Aviation Act 2023 (the Act) by the Acting Minister of Transport, after —

- (a) considering the exercise of the power to require searching to be necessary to -
 - i. improve or enhance aviation security, and
 - ii. enable New Zealand to be part of a concerted international response to a threat to aviation security.
- (b) consulting with -
 - i. the Director of Civil Aviation, and
 - ii. as the Acting Minister of Transport considered appropriate and practical, representative groups in the aviation industry.

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the Notice but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 5 April 2025, amends an incorrect cross-reference in the Civil Aviation (Direction to Require Searching for Inorganic Powders, Liquids, Aerosols, and Gels) Notice 2025.

This notice is secondary legislation and is published by the Ministry of Transport on its website and notified in the *Gazette* as required by the Legislation Act 2019. It amends the direction given by the Acting Minister of Transport to authorised aviation security service providers that all or any of the powers conferred on aviation security officers under this subpart be used by its aviation security officers to detect the items or substances specified in the direction. The notice is consistent with recommended security control guidelines for screening inorganic powders, liquids aerosols, and gels, including those issued by the International Civil Aviation Organization.

This is secondary legislation issued under the authority of the Legislation Act 2019 .
