I refer to your request dated 30 March 2022, pursuant to the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), seeking:

"New Zealand has implemented these ICAO requirements through a Ministerial Direction under s77A of the Civil Aviation Act. We have not been able to secure a copy of those Directions. We would like to **request a copy** of the relevant Ministerial Notice of Direction under the Official Information Act 1986 (sic)."

I am refusing your request under section 18(d) of the OIA, as the information you have requested is already publicly available.
