Amendment to the Land Transport (Infringement and Reminder Notices) **Regulations 2012** NSPOF

Portfolio Transport

On 23 February 2023, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- noted that the Land Transport (Drug Driving) Amendment Act 2022 provides a medical 1 defence if a person has taken their medication as prescribed or administered by their health practitioner;
- 2 noted that in accordance with the Cabinet Manual, the Minister of Transport has authorised consequential amendments to the Land Transport (Infringement and Reminder Notices) Regulations 2012 to include information about the medical defence;
- noted that the Land Transport (Infringement and Reminder Notices) Amendment 3 Regulations 2023 (the Regulations) give effect to the decision referred to in paragraph 2 above:
- authorised the submission to the Executive Council of the Land Transport (Infringement 4 and Reminder Notices) Amendment Regulations 2023 [PCO 25209/3.0];
- 5 noted that a waiver of the 28-day rule is sought:
 - 5.1 so that the Regulations can come into force on 11 March 2023;
 - 5.2 on the grounds that amending infringement and reminder notices to notify recipients of a statutory defence confers only benefits on the public;
- 6 agreed to waive the 28-day rule so that the Regulations come into force on 11 March 2023;
- 7 **noted** that Ministers consider that a waiver of the 28-day rule could have been avoided in relation to these Regulations and noted the need for officials to factor compliance with the 28-day rule into their legislation timeline planning, to avoid this happening in the future.
