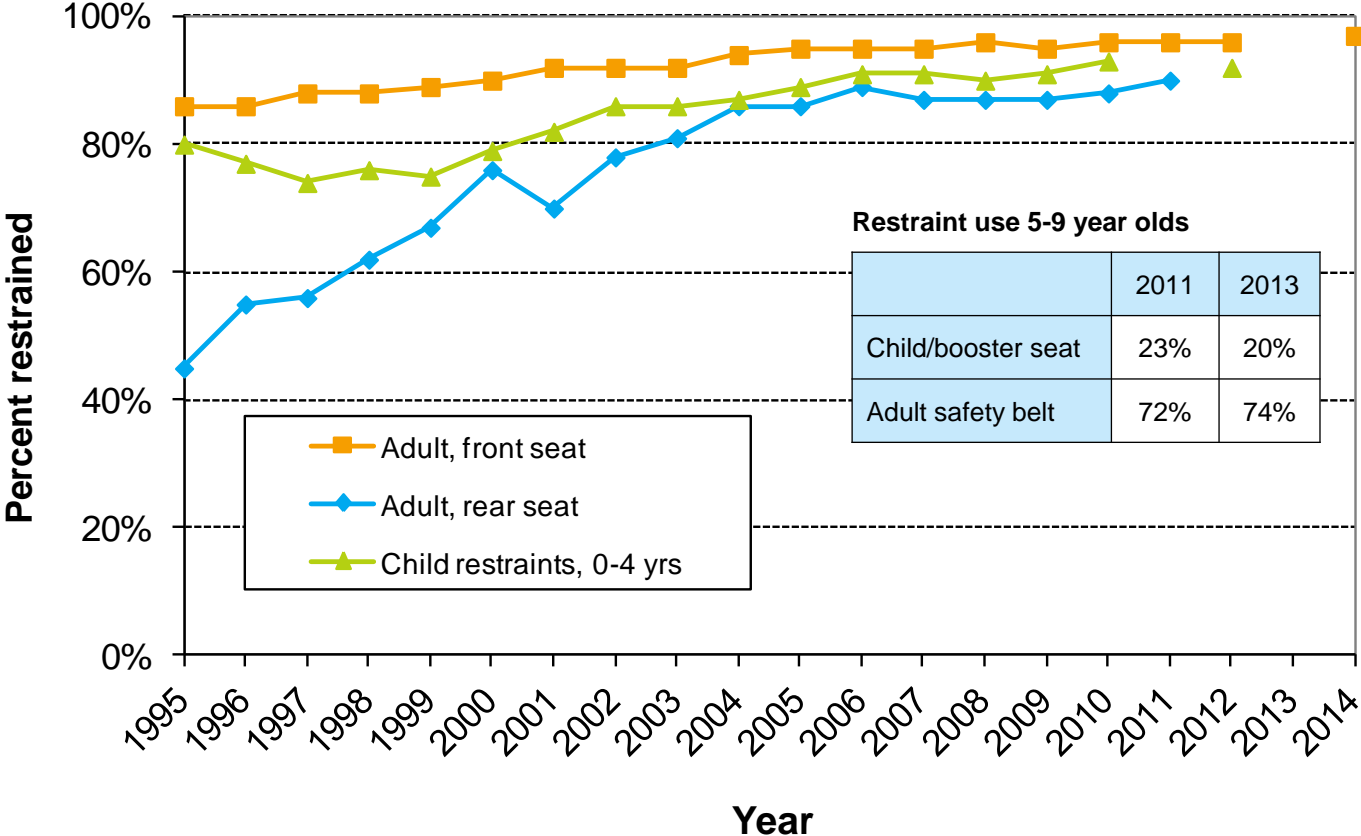


# Safety surveys



- ▶ Restraint use and cycle helmets
  - ▶ *Safety belts – front seat adults (biennial)*
  - ▶ *Child restraints – 0-4 years and 5-9 years (alternate years)*
  - ▶ *Safety belts – rear seat adults (every 3 years)*
  - ▶ *Cycle helmets (every 3 years)*
- ▶ Speed survey (annual)
- ▶ Survey of attitudes to road safety (annual)
- ▶ Cell phone use by drivers (pilot survey)
  
- ▶ Police measurement operations (Ministry of Transport/Police collaboration)
  - ▶ *Heavy vehicle compliance operation (Commercial Vehicle Inspection Unit)*
  - ▶ *Roadside driver alcohol measurement*

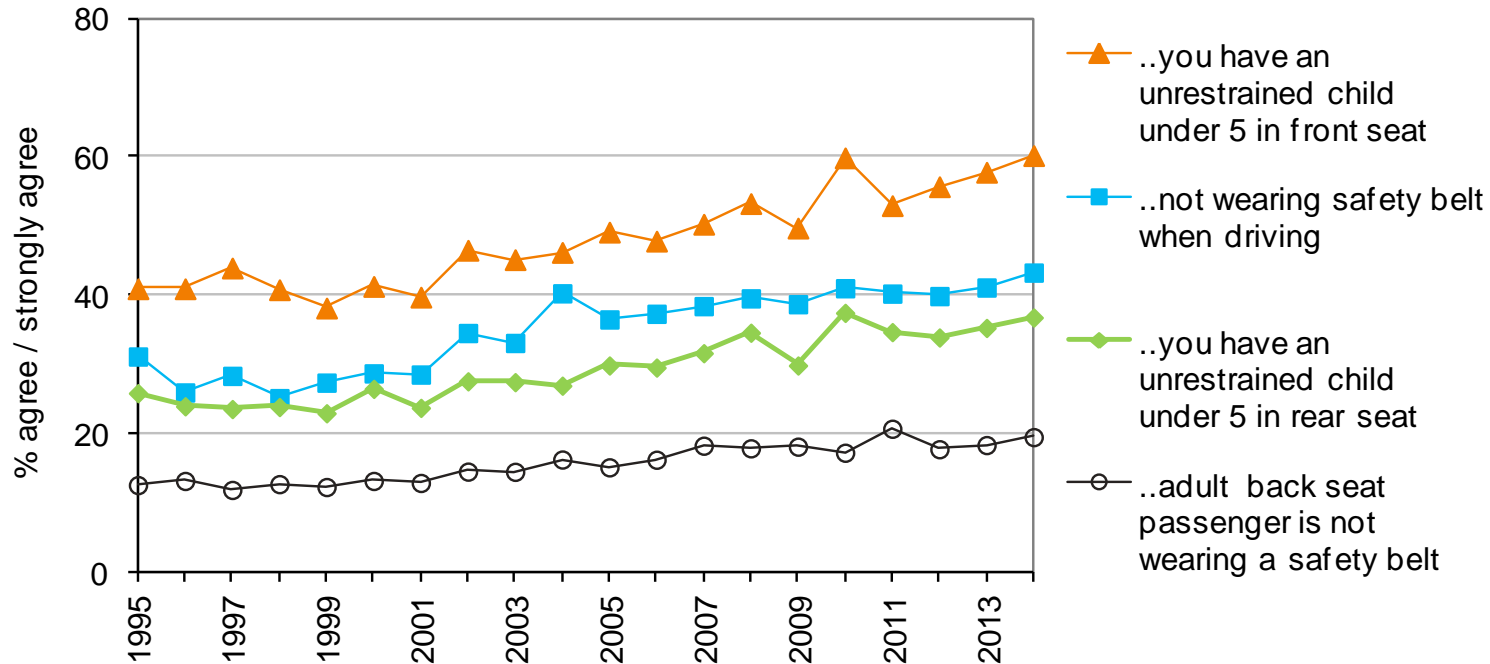

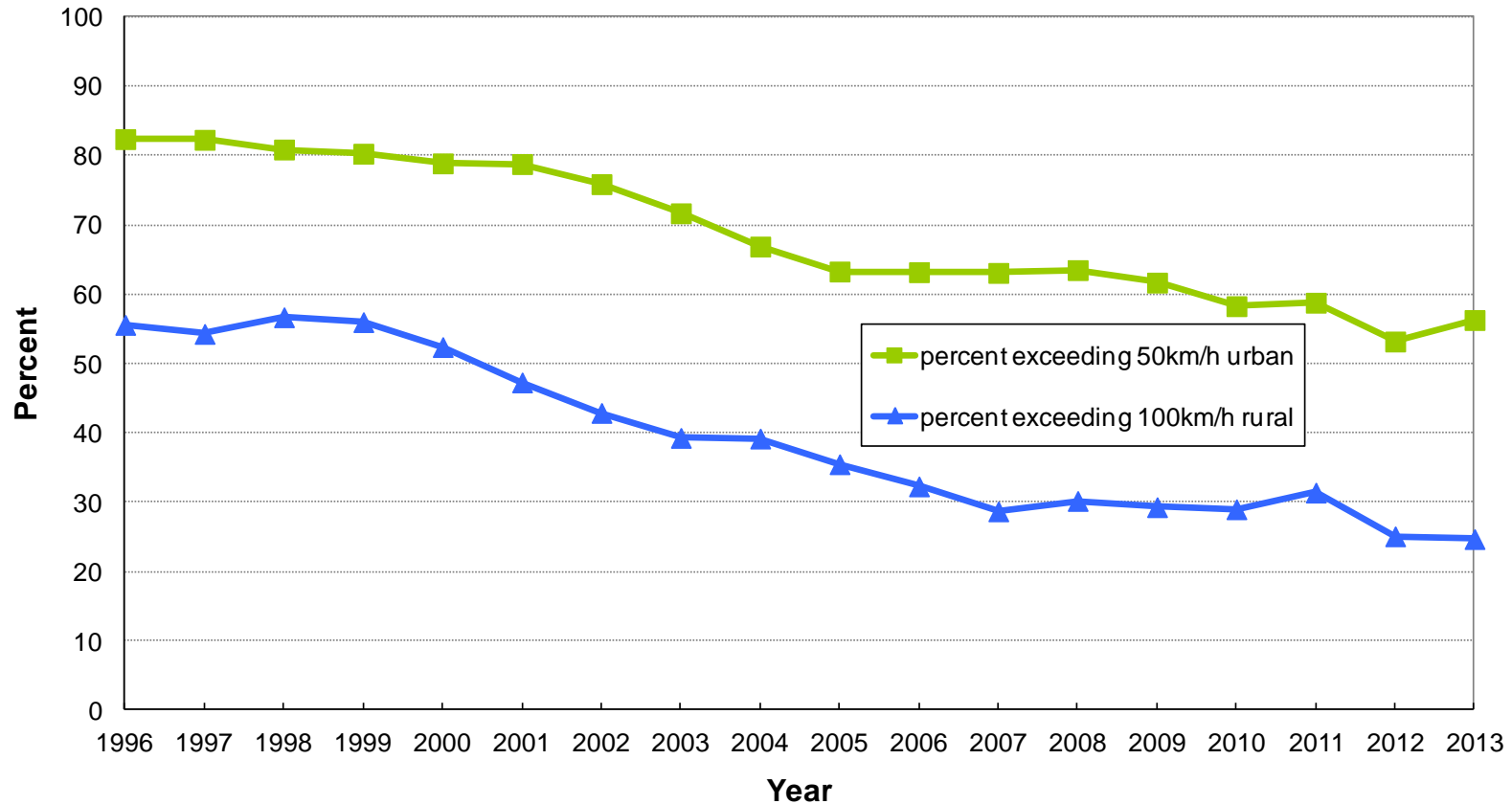
# Attitudes to road safety – restraints



Likely to be stopped/caught if ..



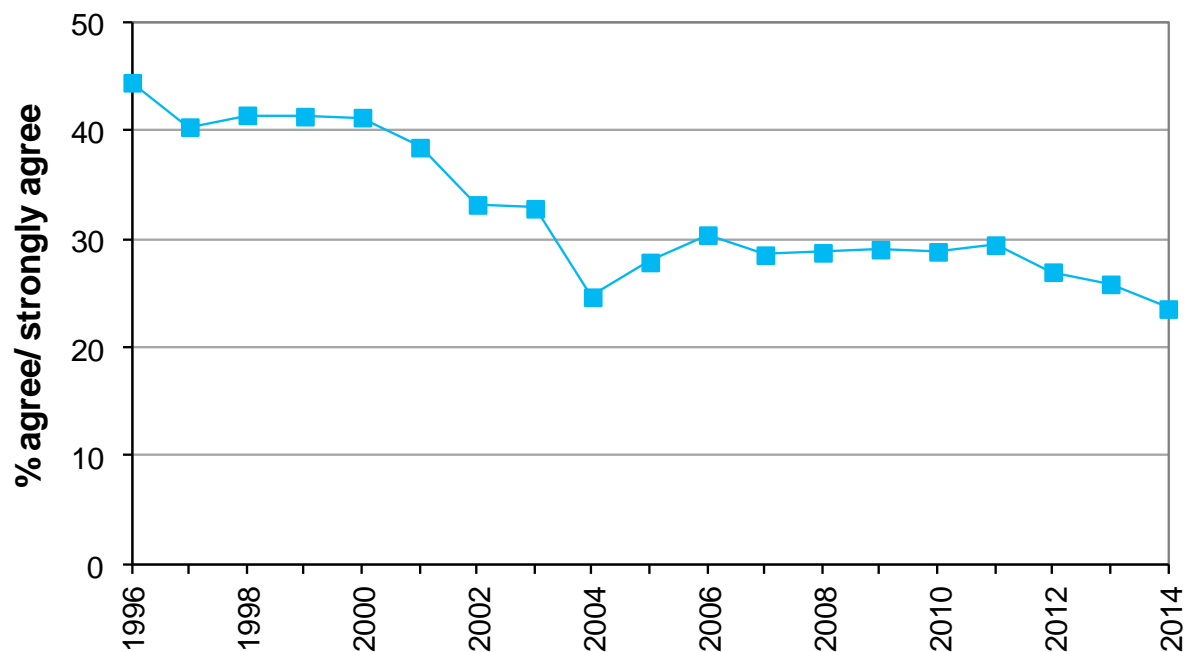
# Speed survey results: Percentage of cars exceeding the speed limit (unimpeded cars)

If speeding the chance of being caught is small

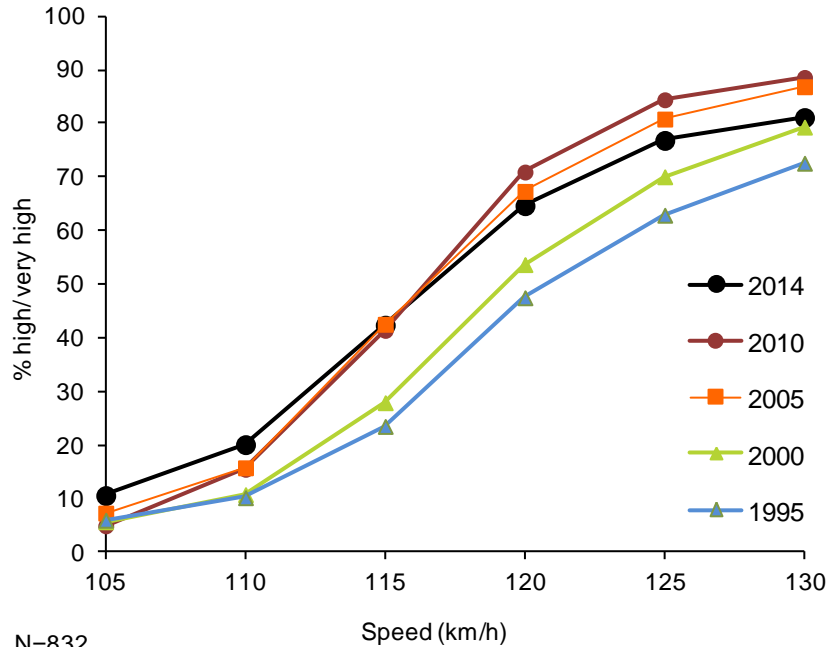


# Attitudes to road safety - speed



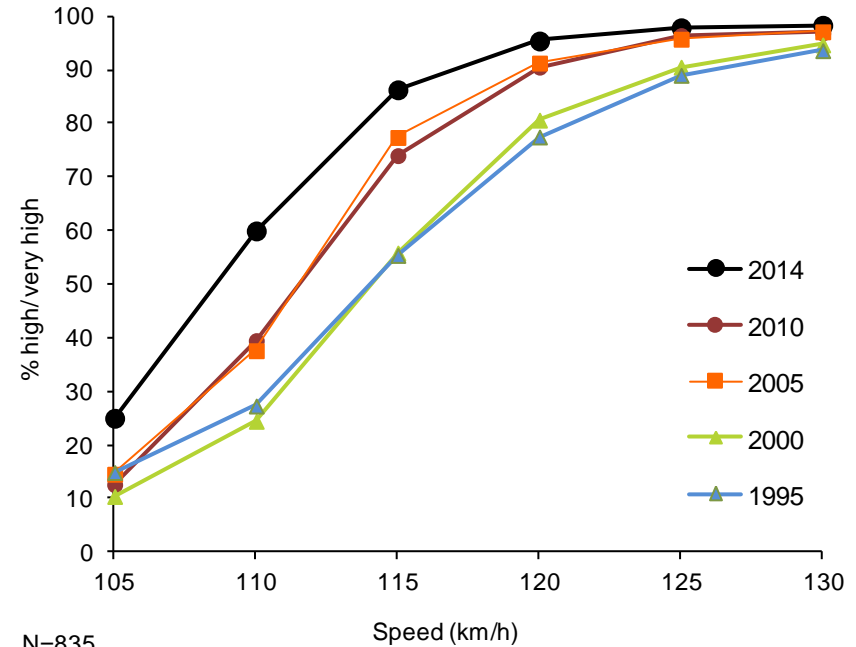
Chance of receiving a speeding ticket if passing a..

..speed camera

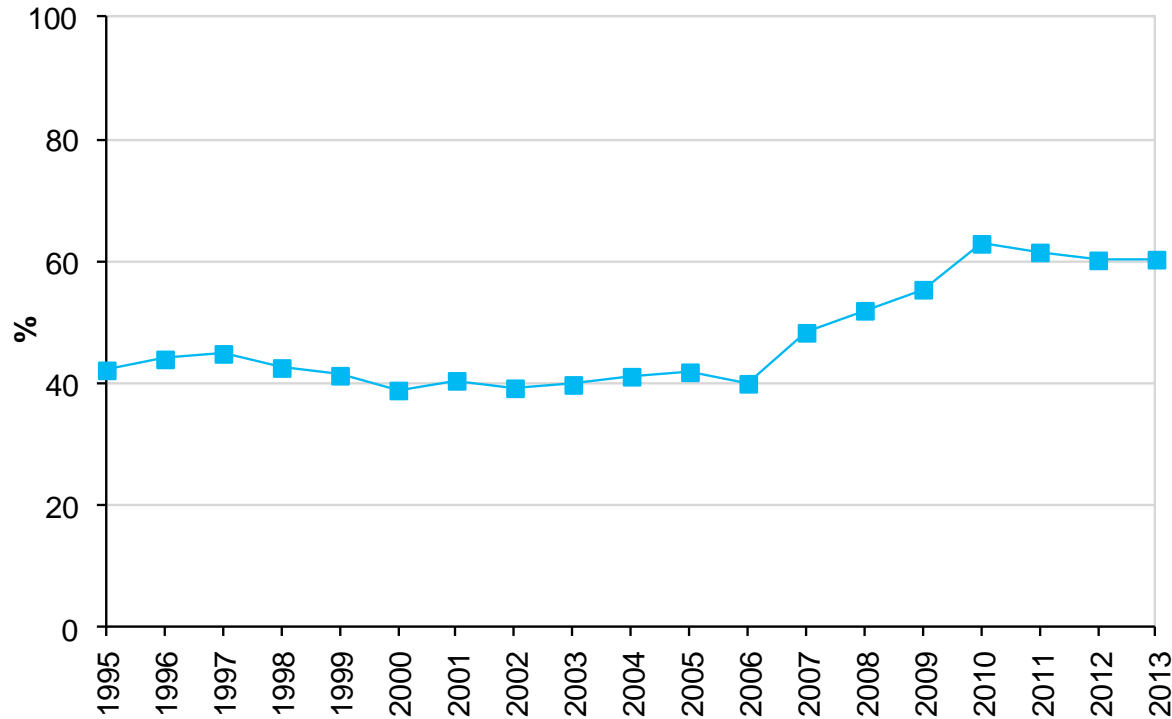

## Percentage saying blood alcohol limit should be lowered

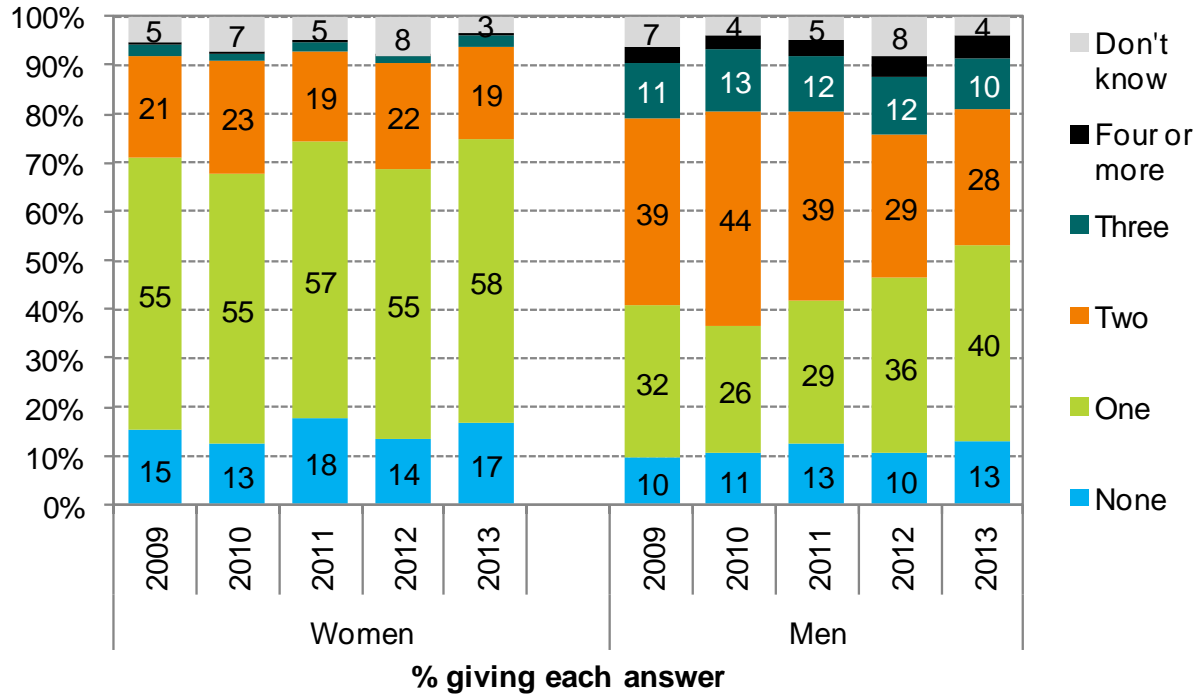




# Attitudes to road safety - alcohol



How many standard drinks should a man/a woman\* be allowed to have in an hour if planning to drive immediately afterwards?

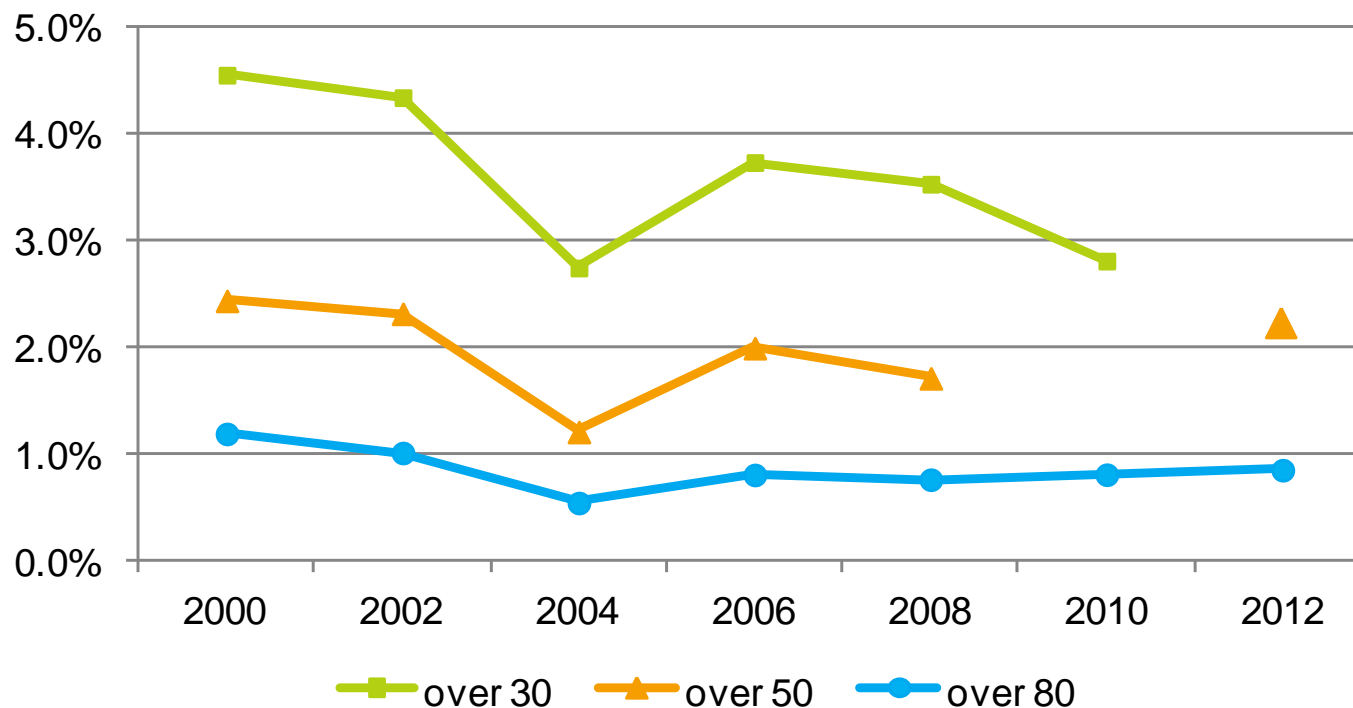


*\*Men were asked about men and women were asked about women.*

# Driver breath alcohol measurement



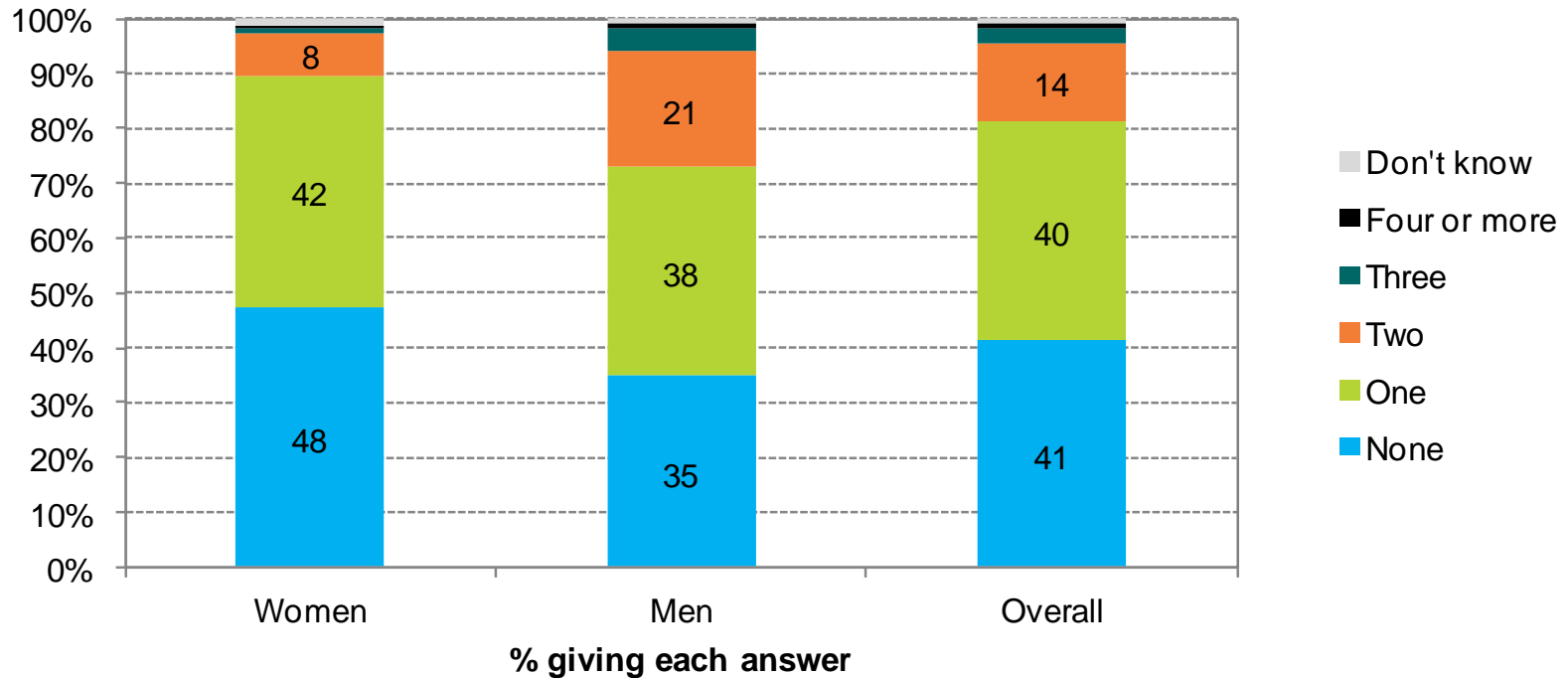
Alcohol levels for drivers aged 20 and over – 10pm-2am Friday and Saturday

# Cell phone use by drivers – pilot survey



Hand-held cell phone use for stationary and moving vehicles

Stationary/Moving	Total surveyed	Phone to head	Probably texting
Stationary	8612	1.1%	4.4%
Moving	29081	1.3%	1.3%
Total	37693	1.3%	2.0%
