I refer to your email dated 1 February 2022, requesting the following under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

- 1. "What GDSs have been archived (between 1 January 2021 and 31 December 2021)?
- 2. What GDSs are new (as in published between 1 January 2021 and 31 December 2021)?
- 3. What GDSs have been moved/shared between departments (between 1 January 2021 and 31 December 2021)?
- 4. What GDS were both new and archived in the 2021 calendar year?"

We have a nil response to your questions 1,3 and 4.

We have four new strategy documents that fall within the scope of your question number 2.

During our research we have found other documents that, while not strictly falling within the scope of your request, we believe you may be interested in. We are including them for completeness of records.

We are providing two tables, attached as Annex One – Document Schedule:

- Table one provides details of the four documents within scope of question 2.
