



Nelson Street Cycleway

The Nelson Street Cycleway will provide a new 3.5km cycleway connecting the Newtown Road (Upper Queen Street) and Quayside areas of Auckland, utilising the disused old Nelson Street off-ramp in two phases. The project enhances work already underway on the Auckland cycle network and is one of two key strategic links into the city.

Benefits: The link bridges a significant gap in the Auckland network and, once completed, will provide a safer, segregated route for cyclists to both the city centre and waterfront areas. This high quality facility will encourage non-cyclists, further raising Auckland’s urban cycling numbers.

Total cost estimate: **\$11 million**

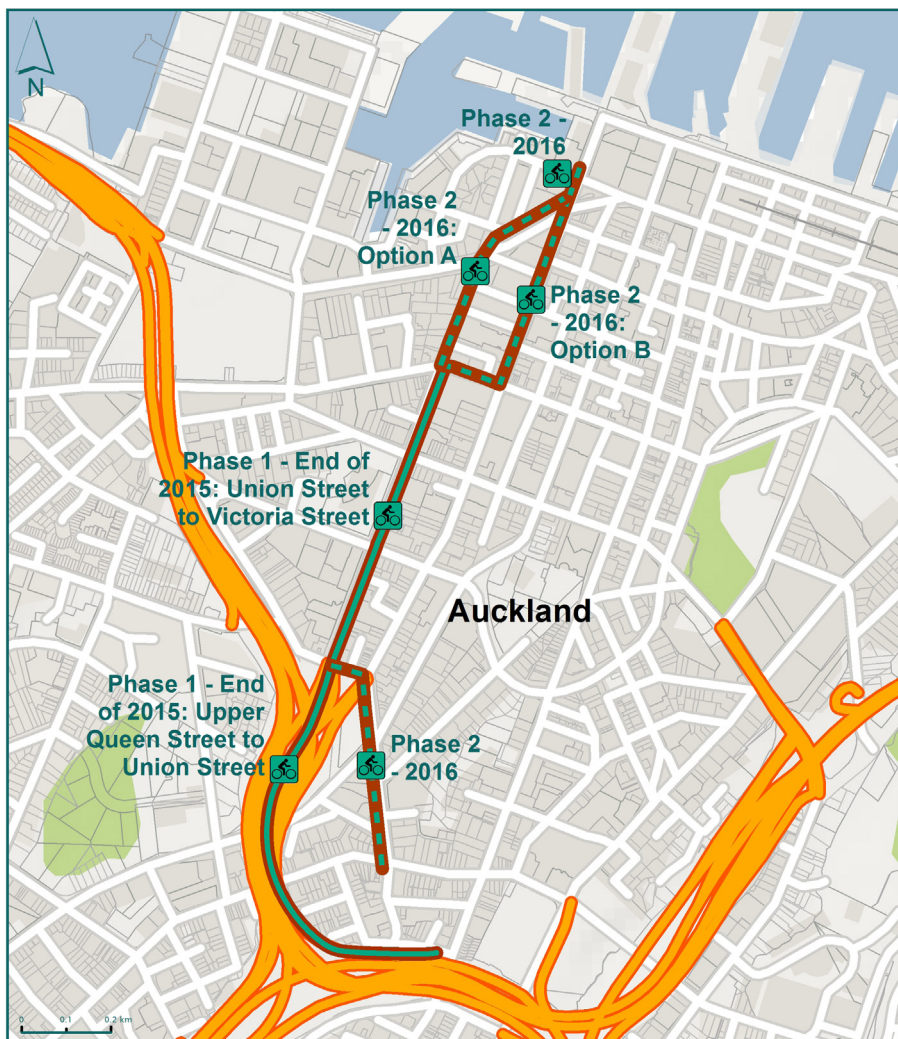

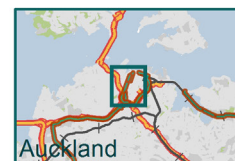
