

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER VARYING A SCHEDULED INTERNATIONAL AIR SERVICE LICENCE

Pursuant to section 184(4)(a)(i) and (ii) of the Civil Aviation Act 2023, and in accordance with section 58(1) and clauses 2 and 4 of Schedule 6 of the Public Service Act 2020, a delegation from the Chief Executive of the Ministry for Cities, Environment, Regions and Transport / Secretary for Transport dated 1 July 2026, I give notice of the proposal to vary the Scheduled International Air Service Licence issued to Air China International to: (i) increase from 7 to 14 the number of passenger services per week the airline may operate; and (ii) amend the route schedule to read:

- “i Points in China, optionally via intermediate points in Australia, to points in New Zealand.
- ii Points in China to points in New Zealand and optionally beyond to points in Australia.”
